Prohibited and Permitted Medicines

(Narcotic drugs and psychotropic
substances /Treatment items/ medicines
subject to special control)

Fair, Simple and Reliable

- ▶ **Narcotic drugs and psychotropic substances;**
- ▶ **Treatment items subjected to special control, treatment items equaled to pharmaceutical products;**
- ▶ **Treatment items.**

Import of which medicines is prohibited in Georgia without relevant documentation?

It is prohibited

To import narcotic drugs, psychotropic substances and their combined preparations to the territory of Georgia without relevant medical documentation!

All combined preparations, which are composed from the following:

ACETYLDIHYDROCODEINE
DIHYDROCODEINE
CODEINE
NICODICODINE
NICOCODINE
NORCODEINE
PHOLCODINE
ETHYLMORPHINE

All combined items, which are composed from the following:

EPHEDRINE
NOREPHEDRINE
PSEUDOEPHEDRINE

Note!

illegal import/export of substances subjected to Special control to Georgia – narcotic drugs, psychotropic substances and their combined preparations – is considered as criminal offence according to criminal code and is punishable by law!

Import in Georgia/export from Georgia of treatment items equaled to pharmaceutical products subjected to special control without relevant medical documentation is prohibited.

What documentation is necessary for importing medicines subjected to special control to the customs territory of Georgia by physical person for personal needs?

For physical person's personal needs, it is permitted to import 31 days reserve of narcotic drugs and psychotropic substances only on the basis of the following documentation:

- ▶ Copy of prescription translated into English and approved by authorized body, in accordance with the legislative rules of the country from where the physical person is traveling;
- ▶ Copy of prescription issuer physician's certificate translated into English and approved by authorized body in accordance with the legislation rules of the country from where the physical person is traveling;
- ▶ Document confirming validity of the prescription and certificate approved by authorized person's signature and seal, which is issued by authorized body of the country from where the physical person is traveling.

Import to/export from Georgia of treatment items equaled to pharmaceutical products subjected to special control by the physical person for personal needs is permitted only on the basis of the following documentation:

- ▶ By Calculating the daily dose of treatment item on quantity of days of physical person's visit (business mission, treatment, tourism, personal invitation and other) to other country;
- ▶ If the physical person is the citizen of Georgia, by calculating the treatment item's daily dose on treatment course;

- ▶ Import/export of more than 10 standard packs of treatment items for physical person's personal use, is permitted based on the relevant medical documentation, by calculating treatment item's daily dose on the quantity of days of the visit to the other country. In case of import of more than 10 standard packs of treatment items by the citizen of Georgia – based on the relevant medical documentation by calculating treatment item's daily dose on the days of treatment course.
- ▶ Import to /export from Georgian territory of 10 standard packs of treatment items for physical person's personal use is permitted without the medical documentation, including import/export of unregistered medicines (except pharmaceutical products subjected to special control and their equivalence).
